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The S.T.A.B.L.E. Program...

is a nationally recognized program that provides guidelines for the assessment and stabilization of sick infants in the post-resuscitation/pre-transport stabilization period. These guidelines are based upon evidence-based recommendations whenever possible. The STABLE Card is awarded upon successful completion of the post-test.

The Program Content...

is detailed in the 6th Edition (2013) S.T.A.B.L.E. **Learner/Provider Manual**. The Course is structured and taught in six Modules: Sugar and Safe Care, Temperature Management, Airway, Blood Pressure, Lab Work, and Emotional Support. Pretest review is strongly recommended.
