Financial Assistance Summary

Clay County Medical Center offers financial assistance to qualified patients. These patients may receive services provided at no charge or at a reduced charge to patients who do not have, or cannot obtain, adequate financial resources to pay for their care.

Requirements and Eligibility

Patients seeking assistance must agree to a financial screening.

Patients who complete and submit a Financial Assistance Application (FAA) must include additional supporting documentation.

Those whose household income falls within 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines are eligible for a discount of services at CCMC.

FAAs and other financial assistance information are available at the Admissions office during work hours, from registration staff, and at www.ccmcks.org.

Patient Accounts Representatives are available to assist patients with financial assistance applications. Their offices are located near the main registration desk or they may be contacted by phone at 785-632-2144 x 471 or 253. Patients may request a free copy of the FAA to be mailed.



The FAA, the Financial Assistance Policy (FAP), and the Plain Language Summary (PLS) are available in English and Spanish.

No private-pay, FAP-eligible individual will be charged more for emergency or other medically necessary care than the amounts generally billed (AGB).

Definition

Amounts generally billed (AGB) means the amounts generally billed for emergency or other medically necessary care to individuals who have insurance covering such care.
